When the female is ready to mate, she produces a sweet sugary fragrance that attracts the male.



Ad envelope. Redpath Sugar was established as the Canada Sugar Refining Company in 1854 in Montreal, Quebec by Scots-Qubecer entrepreneur. After several reorganizations, the company was taken over by American Sugar Refining in 2007.

To mate, the male pushes his body under the female and holds her in place with some hook like structures. The mating may take an hour or two.

The female lays about twelve to forty eggs. The eggs are protected in a leathery case called an ootheca. The female mates only once, and stays pregnant for the rest of her life.
