Cockroach Bay, Florida. The area was named by the early Spanish entering Tampa Bay. In the clear, shallow bay, the Spanish would have seen lots of horseshoe crabs, which look a little like big cockroaches. Cockroach Bay is a place where humans can relax – despite the awful name.
