It is time for my annual report on insect new issues. Again in 2003 we had a drop in the number of new insect issues with a 25% drop following a 38% drop last year. I measure the number of new issues by the height of the stack of 3x5 index cards, one per stamp, that I accumulate each year. (20mm = about 100 cards). Local and known illegal issues are not included. Does anyone else have comparable data for other biological subjects? Is this a general trend or is it just true for insect new issues?
