In the last Ornithology listing I posed a few questions to the members regarding their preference regarding the use of the bird number that has been used for a number of years and whether it was an important piece of information that was being used by the members who collect birds on stamps. I only had about five replies from the members who collect birds on stamps, and except for one email, the other replies do not make use of it, don't know what it is, or have no use for the numbering system. Therefore, this will be the last listing that will make use of the numbering system. If the remaining members, who didn't response to this particular question, feel that an important piece of information is now missing from the listing, you can make your reasons known to me, but I would need a sufficient number requesting this to be restored to the listings to warrant going forward again with the bird number. I have received the new Clements book, Checklist Of Birds of the World, 6th edition, now published by Cornell Laboratory of Ornithology, which follows the same format of Clements' 5th Edition. It now lists 9,930 bird species worldwide.
