In the last Ornithology listing of new birds I indicated that I would no longer be using the Family bird number that was being used prior based on the Clements book, Checklist of Birds of the World. Therefore, this is the first issue under my authorship that now excludes any reference to a bird family number. I have had no additional comments from any of the members that subscribe to Biophilately, specifically from those members who have an interest in birds as written up in the Ornithology section of Biophilately, regarding a “for” or “against” the numbering system that was in use for over fifteen years.

CORRECTIONS/UPDATES

BELARUS

V56(1), Page 26—the prior listing did not include the Scott number.

BENIN

V54(2), Page 66—Songbirds set of 12 with issue date of May 28, 2000.

Update-Per Benin Postal Authorities, this set was not sold in Benin and was not valid for postage. Therefore, this set will not be given Scott numbers. Other sets that shown up in the market place inscribed “Republique du Benin” also were not authorized by Benin Postal officials are as follows:

GUINEA-BISSAU**ISSUED 2001, APRIL 1****A***

Scott Publishing has not listed any new Guinea-Bissau stamp issues in almost twelve years. The last issue in the 2007 catalog was dated October 24, 1995. The sets of owl stamps listed below were issued with nine stamps to each set. One set has the Boys Scout emblem (250f values) and the other set has the Rotary emblem (400f values).

Currently, the Scott catalog has no statement from the Guinea-Bissau postal authorities stating that these issues are “invalid” or “unauthorized”. This could change at some time in the future, whenever Scott Publishing attempts to bring Guinea-Bissau stamps up-to-date since the last issues of 1995.
