It is time for the annual report on insect new issues In calendar 2007 we had a tiny decrease in the number of new insect issues over the previous year. The total number of insect new issues seems to be staying around 300 per year over the past few years. I measure the number of new issues by the height of the stack of 3x5 index cards, one per stamp, that I accumulate each year. (20mm = about 100 cards) Local and known illegal issues are not included.

BUTTERFLY AND MOTH MOTIFS

The latest edition of this book has just been made available and the author (Jack Congrove) had copies for the members of the Butterfly & Moth Unit. The publication is essentially a checklist of butterfly and moth images on stamps and related material of the world. It is arranged with a country listing first of 220 pages of genuine postal issues, followed by 46 pages of local or unofficial issues. Then a systematic list for butterflies (80 pages) and moths (24 pages), followed by a 5 pages bibliography. The systematic list is based on several recent revisions to the taxonomy of the lepidoptera. Total page count is 270, whereas an earlier copy which I have dated 1990, has only 121 pages, perhaps a testament to the popularity of this subject with various issuig authorities!
