Each butterfly has been rendered in impeccable detail by award-winning illustrator and designer Heather Cooper of Toronto. Ms. Cooper based her colourful paintings on specimens from the Canadian National Collection of Insects. She has portrayed each group of butterflies as though in flight, set against a background faintly suggesting the habitat of that species.
