## CORRECTIONS/UPDATES

### MADAGASCAR - V57(3), PAGE 124

**UPDATE:** In V57(3), I wrote up a listing of two sets of bird stamps that I did not have Scott numbers for (I listed them as N/A). At the time I wrote up the article I indicated that these might be either eventually assigned Scott numbers or be declared illegal issues. In the 2009 Scott catalog, these two sets of stamps were officially declared "illegal" by the Madagascar Postal officials. Therefore, these two sets will not be shown in the Scott catalog nor be assigned any Scott numbers for these two sets.
