I don't normally list issues for aerogrammes, pre-stamped envelopes, etc, because the sources I use to get the information for the new issues of birds on stamps don't list these items in advance new issues, nor does Scott Stamp Monthly, or the Scott Stamp Catalog list them. The following items came to me from two sources, so I thought I would list them here. The main source was the European journal of *Flight*. All of these birds have appeared on stamps before. The illustrations of the birds is by Henry Constantine Richter; The designs were done in Lithography by GEON, of Tasmania. This addition information came from literature sent to me by Barbara Herbert of California.

The first listing is of migrating water birds listed as pre-stamped bird images on Aerogrammes. These will not have any Scott numbers assigned to them. The second listing is of Pre-stamped envelopes. The imprinted bird images on both the above sets are taken from John Gould's "The Birds of Australia" (1840-1848).

In V59(1), page 27 and 28, were listed bird definitives of the bird type of 2008. I indicated that a number of them were imprinted with, in addition to the year of 2009, some were showing up with an imprinted date of 2009a and 2009b. In fact, some are now carrying dates of 2009c and 2009d. I have no idea where the Philippine Postal authorities will carry these date scheme listings.

In the new Scott Catalogs of 2011, Scott Publishing has decided to assign Scott numbers to issues that were reprinted with a new date as the only change to a reprinting of a stamp, where before Scott only listed them in the catalog as a footnote. This means that a lot more Scott assigned numbers will now appear for many back issues, and for newer issues for many countries.

This set of Philippine definitives listed in V59(1) was therefore assigned additional numbers due to this year dating scheme by the Philippine Postal Authority and I have listed them for the this set of stamps below. Newer issues not yet assigned an initial Scott number are already appearing on the marketplace with these date interations.
