UPDATE: This stamp, when originally written up, had an assigned Stanley Gibbons number SG1136. Scott Publishing has finally gotten a copy of the stamp and assigned it #751. The designer was D. God, and written printed by Courvoisier in Litho.

QATAR, Vol. 60(2), p.59

UPDATE: The SS written up had no Scott number at the time of forwarding my article to the editor. Scott Publishing assigned #1060 to this SS in their July, 2011, New Issues Update.

SINGAPORE, Vol. 57(2), pp.72-73

UPDATE: This is an update to the June 6, 2007, set of fourteen stamps representing birds, flowers and animals (Sc#1246–1259) of which eight were birds. The stamps have been reissued/reprinted with the same year date of 2007, but each having a number of alphabetic letters with the year date of 2007.

1247 is now known with the date/letters of 2007a-f
1249 is now known with the date/letters of 2007a-d
1251 is now known with the date/letters of 2007a-f

Scott Publishing did not assign new number to each of the reprints, but added the letter to the original number, e.g., 1246a, 1246b, 1246c, etc.

UPDATE: The write-up in Vol. 57(3), page 128, probably should have indicated that Sc#1373, Ostrich, was an addition to the seventh definitive series of bird stamps issued in 2001 and 2002. The perforations on those stamps of 2001 and 2002 are 13. Sc#1373 was reprinted on September 30, 2009, with new perforations of $14\frac{3}{4} \times 14\frac{1}{2}$ and has been assigned Sc#1373a due to the new perforation measurement.

ST. THOMAS & PRINCE ISLANDS

Scott Publishing Company has not updated their catalog for St. Thomas & Prince Islands since 2003. I e-mailed the editor on August 2, 2011, in hopes of getting an update on where Scott Publishing stands with regards to new listings for St. Thomas & Prince. In the meantime, I have decided to list those issues that have birds. The listings below were obtained from Kjell Scharning's web site, "Birdtheme." Should Scott Publishing eventually list any of these issues, assuming that the ones I listed from Kjell's web site are validated by the postal authorities of St. Thomas as valid.

On August 26, 2011, I received an answer to my e-mail to Martin J. Frankevicz, New Issues Editor at Scott Publishing, regarding the status of stamps issued by St. Thomas since 2003, but not yet listed by Scott in their annual *Scott Stamp Catalogue*.
