Updates/Corrections

I just finished putting two years of bird purchases into my albums during the month of February, March, and April, and I find that I have made a number of errors in my prior reporting of new issues. So here goes.

ECUADOR – Vol. 60(4), p.152

Update: When I listed this issue, I missed listing one of the four stamps of the set of Sc#2003a–d. This missed stamp is Sc#2003, Toucan Barbet, *Semnornis ramphastinus*. The stamp originally listed as Sc#2003c is Sc#2003d.

CAPE VERDE – Vol. 59(1), p.19

Correction: Sc#911 was listed as a Common Kestrel. Correct the name to Eurasian Kestrel. Also, Sc#910 was listed as a Common Buzzard, *Buteo buteo*. The bird on this stamp was a subspecies, as I note on the write-up. This subspecies was recently upgraded to a full species status of Verde Buzzard, *Buteo bannermani*, if you want to update your listing.

CHINA TAIWAN – Vol. 58(4), p.120

Correction: Sc#3848 was listed as a yellow-bellied Bush-Warbler. The correct name is Yellowish-bellied Bush-Warbler.

CUBA – Vol. 60(1), p.19

Correction: Sc#5169 was written up as a Cuban Amazon. Correct the name to Cuban Parrot.

FALKLAND ISLANDS – Vol. 60(1), p.20

Update: The sheet of six penguins without white frames around the stamps of Sc#C8–C13 are Sc#C14a–f.

FIJI – Vol. 58(4), p.121

Correction: Sc#1213 was incorrectly listed as an Orange Fruit Dove. It is an Orange Dove. Scientific name as listed is correct.

GAMBIA – Vol. 59(2), p.49

Correction: Sc#3206a, under *Clements Checklist of Birds of the World* is just Sacred Ibis. African Sacred Ibis is listed by a checklist used over in Europe.

GEORGIA – Vol. 60(4), p.152

Correction: Sc#469, Caucasian Grouse, should have the genus name of *Tetrao*, not *Lyrurus*.

GRENADA – Vol. 58(4), p.122

Correction: Sc#3707b had the species scientific name *torquata*. It should be *torquatus*. In addition, Sc#3707c should be Black-and-white Warbler, not Wabler.

GUATEMALA – Vol. 58(4), p.122

Update: Sc#592 was originally written up as a Violaceous Trogon with the scientific name of *Trogon violaceus caligatus*. The stamp has the name of *T. v. braccatus*, a subspecies that was recently elevated to a full species status of Gartered Trogon, *Trogon caligatus*. In Vol. 60(1), p.29, Chuck Braun wrote about the split of Violaceous Trogon into three species, and mentioned the new split of Gartered Trogon as being on stamps from Bequia and Guatemala. Sc#592 is that Guatemalan stamp.

In addition, Sc#593 was written up with the incorrect genus name of *Amalilia*. Correct to *Amazilia*. Sc#594 was also written up with incorrect species name of *rufitorues*. Correct to *rufitorques*.

KOREA DPR (North) – Vol. 60(1), p.22

Update: A souvenir sheet (Sc#4907d) was issued as part of this issue of Sc#4907a–c. The sheet has the three birds, but also has three labels, and one of them has a bird, European Honey-Buzzard, *Pernis apivorus*.

MICRONESIA – Vol. 60(1), p.24

Correction: Sc#855, Brown Booby specie scientific name should be corrected to *leucogaster*, not *leuogaster*.

NAMIBIA – Vol. 61(1), p.45

Correction: Stamp listed as Sc#1206d should be Sc#1206e.

NETHERLANDS ANTILLES - Vol. 59(1), p.26

Correction: Sc#1210a, Red-throated Caracara's genus name should be *Ibycter*, as listed by the Clements Checklist, Sixth Edition.

NETHERLANDS ANTILLES – Vol. 60(1), p.26

Correction: Sc#1265b, correct the genus spelling to *Neopelma*, not *Neopilma*. Sc#1265e, the correct scientific name spelling is *Empidonomus varius*.

NEW CALEDONIA – Vol. 59(1), p.27

Correction: Sc#1067a genus name should be *Sternula*, not *Sterna*.

PHILIPPINES – Vol. 59(1), p.28

Correction: Sc#3206h, the Flaming Sunbird's correct scientific name is *Aethopyga flagrans*.

PHILIPPINES – Vol. 58(2), p.49

On the sheet of 17 stamps issued for the Asian International Stamp Exhibition held in Jakarta, the stamps have the year date of 2008, and Sc#3177j. Also, all the sunbird stamps on the stamp face different corners than those printed with a 2009 date on the stamps.

ROMANIA – Vol. 60(2), p.59

Correction: Sc#5184, Pygmy Cormorant, should have *Phalacorcorax* as a genus name.

ST LUCIA – Vol. 59(4), p.148

Correction: Sc#1262 should be Sc#1265.

SIERRA LEONE – Vol. 59(3), p.98

Correction: Sc#2964 incorrectly listed as a Black-chested Snake-Eagle. It should be Black-breasted Snake-Eagle. The stamp itself has the incorrect name, but the correct scientific name.

SINGAPORE – Vol. 60(3), p.97

Correction: Sc#1453c is missing the letter "r" on the species name—should be *leucogaster*

SOUTH AFRICA – Vol. 59(3), p.101

Correction: Correct name to Jackass Penguin from African Penguin. Also, in Vol. 60(3), p.97, correct genus name to *Hemimacronyx* from *Anthus*.

SYRIA – Vol. 59(3), p.101

Correction: Sc#1664e species spelling should be *cineracea* instead of *ceneracea*.

UKRAINE – Vol. 58(3), p.90

Correction: Sc#759 should be listed as a Cuban Parrot, instead of Cuban Amazon, as per Clements Checklist of Birds of the World, Sixth Edition.

Checking the 2012 Scott Stamp Catalog, they did list issues for the 32nd, 33rd, and 34th anniversaries, but the 33rd does not list this particular sheet.

I emailed Scott Publishing with a photo of this sheet and I received a reply that they are aware of the sheet, but have not been able to get their hands on it to examine it. So, if any collector out there, reading this has this sheet, Scott would appreciate reviewing it before listing it. I have mailed issues to Scott so that they can examine them and then received them back. They take very good care of them and you would get it back in the same good condition it was it when forwarded to them. ST THOMAS & PRINCE ISLANDS

Scott Publishing has finally assigned numbers to a slew of issues, but only issues through year 2007. In addition, Saint Thomas has stated that any stamps dated "2004" were not put on sale in Saint Thomas & Prince, which would declare them illegal, as well as a quantity dated with the years "2005" and "2006." See Biophilately, Vol. 60(3), p.96. This is barely a dent in the number of stamps with birds listed in the Ornithology since 2006.

In Vol. 60(3), p.95, the December 15, 2006, issue was assigned Sc#1639a—d. The issue I listed had items in the background in silver. Saint Thomas states this issue was also printed with these items having a gold background. Change the issue I listed from "n/a" to 1639b&d and add a Sc#1649b&d for the gold background issue.

A sheet for threatened species, issued May 25, 2006, was assigned Sc#1598a-d. Change the "n/a" to 1598a for the barn owl.

The second listing from Vol. 60(3), p.95, with the date February 2, 2007, has also been assigned numbers by Scott Publishing. The date of issue is listed as February 15, 2007, as per postal authorities of Saint Thomas. The sheet of owls is Sc#1683a–d, and the sheet for the Polar Year is Sc#1682b (9000db values) and Sc#1682c (14,000db values).
