CONGO PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC 2008?

It is time for the annual report on insect new issues. In calendar year 2011, we had a slight increase in the number of new insect stamps, but still the fourth lowest in the past 16 years. I measure the number of new issues by the height of the stack of 3×5 index cards, one per stamp, that I accumulate each year (20mm = about 100 cards). Local and known illegal issues are not included.
