## **TURKS & CAICOS SNAKES**

Because 2013 is the Year of the Snake in the Chinese calendar, we have had a plethora of snake issues this year. The majority of these issues show highly stylized and even cartoonish images.

That is all fine and many designs are very artistic and appealing, but we are dealing with Biology in this study unit, so I want to highlight one of the few issues that shows an actual native species in an attractive design using natural colors.



On 12 July 2013, the Turks and Caicos Islands issued a set of two stamps and a SS to commemorate the Year of the Snake. These stamps show the Turks Island Boa, *Chilabothrus chrysogaster* Cope (Boidae). This species is found in both the southern Bahamas and the Turks and Caicos Islands. They are nocturnal and feed on lizards, birds, and rodents, which makes them good pest controllers.

Adults can reach a length of more than 70 inches, but typically they are closer to three feet in length. This species has three color morphs: spotted, striped, and no-pattern. The spotted version seems to be the most common, followed by striped. The no-pattern snakes, which are mostly solid gray with a few dark markings, are very rare. Juveniles are orange or red and long and thin. Rarely, some adults may retain the juvenile coloration.



These snakes are threatened by introduced predators such as cats, misguided human persecution, and loss of habitat.
