Pelican says he's just ...

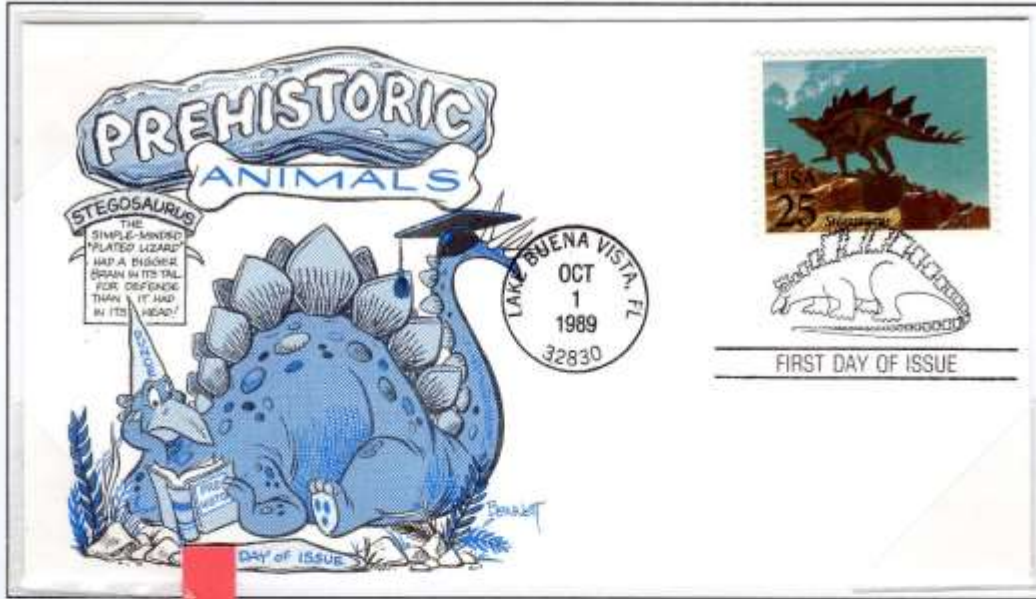
"Sittin' in the morning sun - I'll be sittin' when the evening comes ...
