

Ornithology

Since this is the first Biophilately of the new year, I want to explain the far right column in the new issue listings. I use a letter code (A*, B*, or C*) following the issue description. This is the same code first used in ATA Handbook 106, *Birds of the World in Philately*, as follows:

A = one species of bird as the sole or central subject of the stamp(s);

B = two or more species of birds as the major subjects, or one species as an important but not sole or central element of the design;

C = one or more species of bird(s) as a small or extraneous part of the design;

* = the bird(s), but not necessarily the rest of the design, shown in color.

I also use the far right column to designate if the species shown on the stamp is new to our Philatelic Aviary. That is, it has never been depicted on a previous stamp issue. I use two designations as follows:

NEW = new species on stamp not previously reported in Biophilately;

V51(1) = new species on stamp previously reported as an uncataloged issue in the Philatelic Aviary section of Biophilately Volume 51 #1. This happens when the Philatelic Aviary editor publishes the species information before the Ornithology editor publishes the issue information. This designation then becomes a cross reference between two volumes of Biophilately for the same stamp.

ONLINE vs PRINT EDITION JOURNALS

I have recently changed my subscriptions to “*Linn’s Stamp News*” and “*Scott Stamp Monthly*” to the online editions. I did this first of all to reduce paper usage and secondly I thought it would speed up my work on the ornithology new issues because I could now cut and paste the information and avoid the typos that sometimes creep in when I enter the information by hand. Also, I have always had a minor problem with the catalog update section of SSM because of the small font used and often have had to use a magnifier to read it and I thought this problem would be solved by using the online edition.

To use the online editions one has to go to the appropriate website www.linnsonline.com or www.scottonline.com and change the subscription from print to online. You also have the option of receiving both online and print editions at double the cost and you can switch back to the print edition if you do not like the online edition. You will need the account number(s) on the mailing label(s) to verify that you are a current subscriber and then you will have to enter all of your demographic information on each website. You then choose a user name and password on each website. There is a quirk here that will not allow you to use the same user name on both websites. ScottOnLine and LinnOnLine must share the same user name database because when I tried to use the same user name it was not allowed.

After you have signed up and selected a user name and password you enter them on the opening screen and click on the ‘Submit’ button. You then will receive a secure site dialog box followed by a redirection to a non-secure site dialog box unless you have turned off these options. I leave these on because I like to be reminded when I am entering a secure site. You then receive a welcome screen to the ActivePaper Reader asking you to select the type of internet connection you are using with a choice of dial-up or broadband. This screen also has notes reminding you to enable cookies and informing

AOL users to apply full screen view for best results. It would seem to me that this info could be stored in your demographic info to avoid having to see this screen everytime you log on. The next screen is your interface to the online edition you have chosen to use. ScottOnLine takes much longer to load than LinnsOnLine and I believe this is due to ScottOnLine's heavy reliance on graphic images which brings me to the major problem with ScottOnLine.

Most of the catalog update section is unreadable. I believe this is due to the usage of the same font and the fact that this section is not text but GIF images of the print edition. I have tried using several screen magnifiers ranging in price from free to several hundred dollars. None of them work because they cannot enhance the GIF image and the result of magnification is resolution loss which makes the image even worse. Also because of the GIF images one cannot use the ActivePaper Reader view window on the catalog update section. This window normally allows a quick view that converts the newspaper text to a more readable columnar version using a different font but use of the view window in the catalog update section results in a blank window. I would suggest that anyone who depends upon the catalog update section stay with the print edition until Scott decides to change the format of the online edition. I have been in touch with the technical support group and they have forwarded my emails to the editorial section. If others are experiencing the same frustrations I would suggest mailing/emailing your concerns to the editorial staff of SSM. I have decided to stay with the online edition because I get most of my new issue information from LinnsOnLine's new issue section and use ScottOnLine mainly for the catalog numbers which I have so far been able to deduce.
