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### GOLIATH BEETLES

The recent issues of Zambia showing 2 different goliath beetles prompted a study of the various species of *Goliathus*, Family Scarabaeidae, Subfamily Cetoniinae. It is generally accepted that there are five species, some with several subspecies as shown in [www.naturalworlds.org/goliathus](http://www.naturalworlds.org/goliathus)

*Goliathus goliatus* Drury (1770) (or L. 1771) (current usage omits the H in the species name)

Subspecies *goliatus*, *apicalis*, *conspersus*, *undulus* Sjostedt, *albatus* Kraatz, *quadrifasciatus* Sjostedt

*Goliathus regius* Klug (1835)

*Goliathus cacicus* Voet (1779) (or Olivier 1789) (some authors use *cassicus*)

*Goliathus orientalis* Moser (1909)

Subspecies *orientalis*, *preissi*, *pustulatus*, *undulatus* (or *undulus* Sjostedt)

*Goliathus albosignatus* Boheman (1857)

Subspecies *albosignatus*, *kirkianus*

For the purposes of differentiating the above five species, the following descriptions can be used:

*G. goliatus* – elytra are rusty brown to rusty red, much variability

*G. regius* – wide black bands on the sides of the elytra, large patches of white

*G. cacicus* – pronotal shield is tawny yellow (male), elytra have a bluish iridescence

*G. orientalis* – many small white spots ringed in black

*G. albosignatus* – curved transverse black bands, some orange on the elytra  
Has not appeared on stamps

Many labels of *Goliathus* species on stamps simply call them goliath beetle or *goliath giganteus*. As a result of the above descriptions, I now list the species of *Goliathus* as follows:
